# GEORGIA SUPREME CRICKET LEAGUE (GASCL)

## FULL T20 PLAYING CONDITIONS – 2026

These Playing Conditions are issued under the authority of the GASCL Constitution and By-Laws. They incorporate applicable ICC Playing Conditions while remaining specific to GASCL competitions. In the event of conflict, GASCL governance documents prevail.

## **1. DEFINITIONS & AUTHORITY**

- 1.1 These Playing Conditions apply to all GASCL T20 competitions.
- 1.2 Except where varied herein, the Laws of Cricket (MCC) and ICC T20 Playing Conditions apply.
- 1.3 The on-field umpires are the sole judges of fact; GASCL officials are the final judges of interpretation.

## **2. MATCH FORMAT & TIMING**

- 2.1 Each match shall consist of one innings per side, limited to 20 overs.
- 2.2 The scheduled start time shall be published in advance. Failure to take the field within thirty (30) minutes of the scheduled start time may result in forfeiture.
- 2.3 Interval between innings shall not exceed ten (10) minutes.

## **3. POWERPLAY & FIELDING RESTRICTIONS**

- 3.1 Powerplay overs shall be the first six (6) overs of the innings.
- 3.2 During the Powerplay, no more than two (2) fielders may be outside the 30-yard circle.
- 3.3 After the Powerplay, no more than five (5) fielders may be outside the circle.

## **4. BOWLING RESTRICTIONS**

- 4.1 No bowler may bowl more than four (4) overs.
- 4.2 Bowling quotas shall be recalculated proportionally in reduced-overs matches.
- 4.3 No bowler may bowl consecutive overs.

## **5. IMPACT PLAYER (T20 ONLY)**

- 5.1 Each team may nominate two (2) Impact Players prior to the toss.
- 5.2 Only one (1) Impact Player may be used during the match.
- 5.3 The substitution must occur at the conclusion of an over and be reported to the umpires.
- 5.4 Impact Players must be registered and may bat and bowl in accordance with standard limits.

## **6. NO BALLS, WIDES & FREE HITS**

- 6.1 ICC front-foot no-ball laws shall apply.
- 6.2 A free hit shall be awarded for all front-foot no-balls.

6.3 All modes of dismissal except run out shall be invalid on a free hit.

## **7. INTERRUPTED MATCHES & DLS**

7.1 A minimum of six (6) overs per side is required for a result.

7.2 The Duckworth-Lewis-Stern (DLS) Method, as implemented via the CricClubs DLS App, shall be mandatory.

7.3 The DLS outcome recorded in CricClubs shall be final.

## **8. BALLS, BOUNDARIES & EQUIPMENT**

8.1 GASCL-approved match balls shall be used.

8.2 Boundary markers shall define the field of play and must be clearly visible.

8.3 Protective equipment must meet ICC safety standards.

## **9. SUBSTITUTES, INJURIES & CONCUSSION**

9.1 Substitutes may field only and may not bat or bowl.

9.2 Concussion replacements may be approved by umpires upon medical assessment.

## **10. OVERRATES & DELAYED PLAY**

10.1 Teams are expected to maintain a reasonable over rate.

10.2 Persistent delays may result in penalties imposed by GASCL.

## **11. RESULTS, POINTS & TIES**

11.1 Win: 10 points; Loss: 0 points.

11.2 Abandoned or No Result matches award 5 points each.

11.3 Ties shall stand; no Super Overs apply unless separately approved by GASCL.

## **12. DISCIPLINE & FINAL AUTHORITY**

12.1 Umpires may remove players for misconduct.

12.2 GASCL MEC is the final authority on interpretation and enforcement.

## RATIFICATION & ADOPTION

These documents were reviewed and approved by the Georgia Supreme Cricket League (GASCL).

Formal ratification and officer signatures shall occur upon completion of the February GASCL elections.
